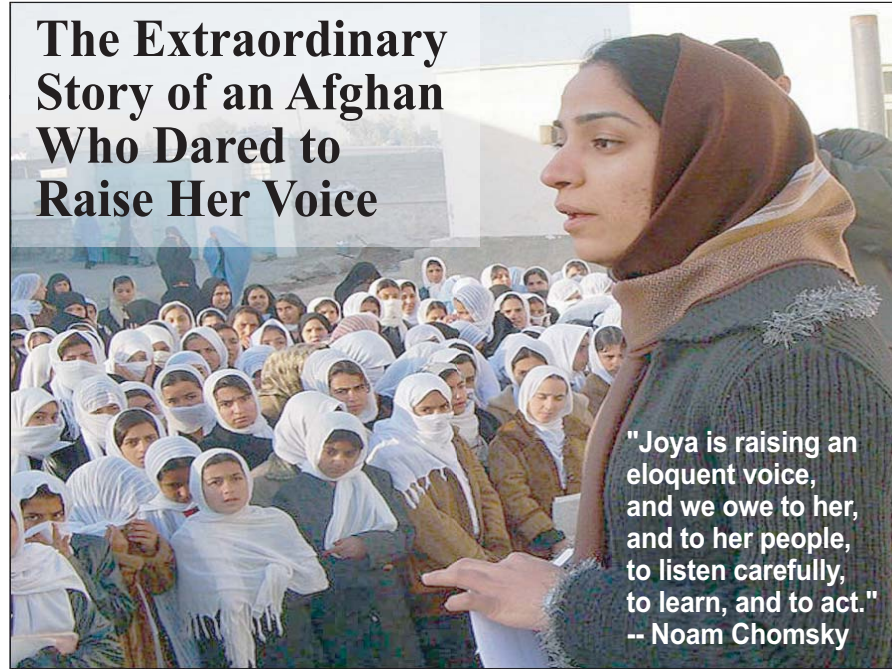


A Woman Among Warlords
